

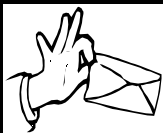

PRESIDENT'S DAY HOLIDAY

Monday, February, 19th is a National holiday.
The **Rectory** will be **closed** for the day.

ASH WEDNESDAY, the beginning of Lent, is
February 21st. Masses will be at 6:30 am, 8:30
am and 7:30 pm. Ashes will be given out during
each Mass, and at a simple service with the
School of Religion at 3:45 pm.

ABSTINENCE: Everyone 14 years of age and older
is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday,
each Friday of Lent, and Good Friday.

FAST: 18-60 years of age on Ash Wednesday &
Good Friday. On these two days the law of fasting
allows only one full meal a day, but does not
prohibit taking some food during the day, as long
as this does not constitute another full meal.
Drinking liquids during the day is permitted.

after the 8:30am Mass and again at 7:30pm.

Financial assistance available.

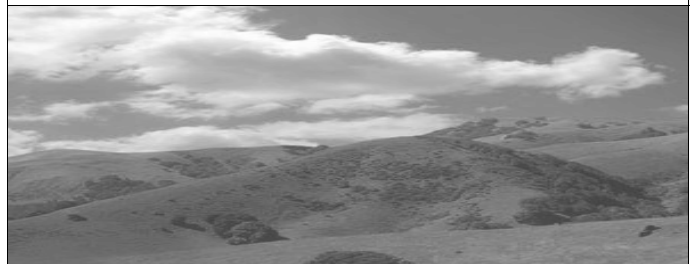
