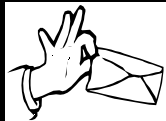

### RULES of FASTING and ABSTINENCE

**ABSTINENCE:** Everyone 14 years of age and older is bound to abstain from meat on each Friday of Lent, and Good Friday.

**FAST:** 18-60 years of age on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. On these two days the law of fasting allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food during the day, as long as this does not constitute another full meal. Drinking liquids during the day is permitted.
