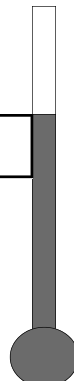

The name “Veronica” seems to derive from the Greek and Latin words *vera icona*, meaning *real icon* or *authentic image*, referring to the cloth which, according to ancient tradition, a saintly woman used to wipe the face of Jesus on his way to crucifixion. Christ is said to have left the imprint of his face on the veil which is honored as a treasured relic at St. Peter’s in Rome, and is commemorated in the sixth station of the cross.

Relic. An object connected with a saint, e.g., part of the body or clothing or something the person had used or touched. Authentic relics are venerated with the Church’s warm approbation. They may not be bought or sold. Those of a martyr are placed in the altar stone at the consecration of an altar. Relics are of three classes: the first is part of the saint’s body and is the type placed in the altar stone; the second is part of the clothing or anything used during the saint’s life; and the third is any other object, such as a piece of cloth, that has been touched to a first-class relic. (Etym. Latin *reliquiae*, remains.)

We read about relics in the Acts of the Apostles: “So extraordinary were the mighty deeds God accomplished at the hands of Paul that when face cloths or aprons that touched his skin were applied to the sick, their diseases left them and the evil spirits came out of them.” —Acts 19:11-12

Perhaps you have some “relics” or reminders of people you’ve loved—objects which help you recall that person’s love and memory. Such objects have no power of their own, but may help us understand why Catholics hold relics of the saints in such high regard. We preserve them; we are stewards of relics. If we use them in faith as reminders of the reality of God’s love which was with us *in person*, in Jesus Christ, we can deepen our belief in the Communion of Saints, and know that they’re very close to us.

The Confirmation Program is separate from the Religious Education program.

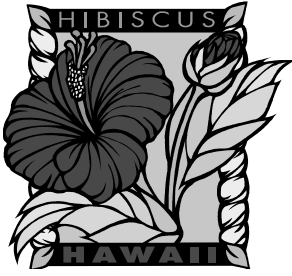
