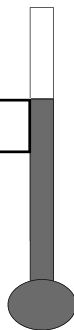
### **ARCHBISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL COLLECTION UPDATE**

### **DONOR SOUGHT**

Help save Marco Ocbena, who has Acute Lymphocytic Leukemia (blood cancer), and other patients who need bone marrow transplants. A representative of the Asian American Donor Program will evaluate and oversee the registration of bone marrow donors. It's easy—you must be between the ages of 18-60, meet the health guidelines, fill out the form and give a cheek swab. If you are a match, the stem cell transplant is through an IV—NO SURGERY, and your bone marrow regenerates after two to three weeks.
