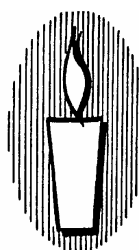

September 14 Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross

This feast commemorates the discovery of the Lord's cross by the empress, Saint Helena, in

the year A.D. 320, and also when Emperor Constantine erected a round church, the Anastasis, above the empty grave of Jesus; a basilica, the Martyrium; and in the square between the two churches, a shrine, Calvarium, marking the place of the crucifixion.
