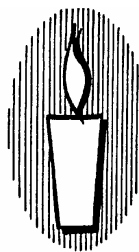

TRADITIONAL LATIN MASS

Are you interested in seeing the Traditional Latin Mass return to St. Veronica's? Well, Congratulations! Pope Benedict and your pastor Fr. Bohnert are also interested in this possibility. Please read the following and let's see what we, St. Veronica's parishioners, can do to bring the Traditional Latin Mass back:

Implementing Summorum Pontificum

The following are some tips on how you can take advantage of the new papal motu proprio to establish a traditional Latin Mass in your parish.

First, try to find how many people in your parish would be interested in the schedule. You can do this by meeting people after Mass or by word of mouth or telephone calls. When you find one, ask that person to help find others. When you have a reasonable number (you can count all children and family members as individual people), write a letter to your pastor, requesting the traditional Latin Mass in conformity with Pope Benedict's document, *Summorum Pontificum*.

You can either include the name of each person who is interested in the Mass, or ask each to write separately.

Write with courtesy and brevity. You should not mention any negative experiences you have had in the parish.

You can request the Mass for both Sundays and weekdays. This does not obligate you to attend every day or every week or every month.

If you know of a priest who is willing and able to offer the Mass, mention that. This will be a tremendous help because your pastor may not know of a priest who would be able to offer the traditional Mass.

Wait a month for a response. If you have not heard back in a month, write to the pastor again, the same letter. If he does not respond within another month, write to the bishop, mentioning that you have not heard from your pastor.

Keep copies of the letter, and the pastor's response, if any.

If your pastor does not respond in a favorable manner, send all of your correspondence to Cardinal Castrillon Hoyos, Pontifical Commission Ecclesia Dei (address below):
