Many were terrified, and thought that the world was ending as the sun appeared to come closer and closer to earth. When the sun returned to its place, they were all dry!

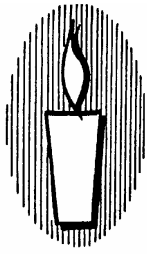
