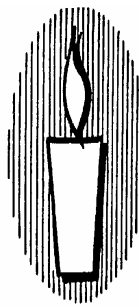

October 13th marks ninety (90) years since the final apparition of Our Lady to the three visionaries in Fatima, Portugal.
