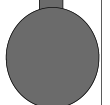

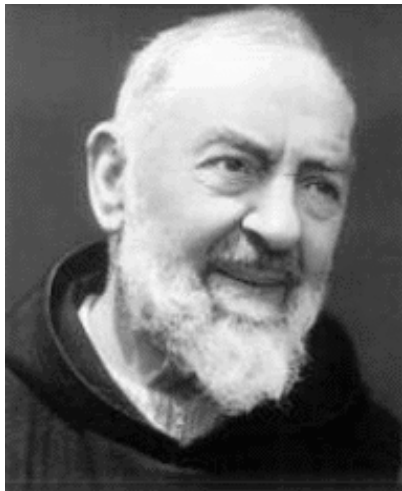

St. Veronica's Finance Committee, the Pastor, Father Ed and the Principal, Teri Pallitto are working together on the following repairs and upgrades to our Parish and School buildings and grounds:

Completed Projects:

- Painting of the outside of the School Building
- Painting of the Cafeteria – outside & inside
- Cleaning and polishing of the Parish Center floor
- New windows for School Classrooms
- New window blinds for Cafeteria
- Removal of five dying large trees on parish property
- Purchase of six new tables for the Cafeteria

Future Projects to be completed within one year:

- Painting of exterior of Church, Rectory, and Parish Center buildings
- Purchase and installation of a new six-foot-high fence around the Parish and School property
- Purchase and installation of new fire alarm system for School

Future Projects under consideration:

- Architect study to convert the Convent first floor into a Day Care Facility
- Architect study to convert the Convent second floor into St. Veronica Middle School
- Transfer kindergarten class from the Convent back to the School
- Leasing and installation of a used modular building for Religious Education and Parish organization meetings
- Proceed with Architect's recommendations with approval from the Pastor, Principal, Archdiocese building department and South San Francisco city codes
- Re-paving the entire parking lot
- Special grotto dedicated to our Blessed Virgin Mary
- Upgrading the Church Basement to SSF city codes

**Openings: St. Veronica Adult Choir**

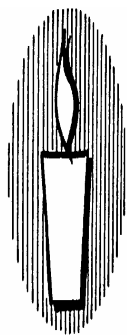
New members are always welcome, and practices are held in the church at 7PM every Thursday.
