Future Projects to be completed within one year:

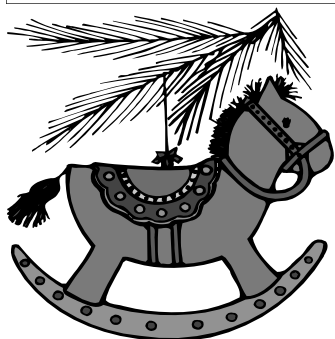
- Painting of exterior of Church, Rectory, and Parish Center buildings

- Re-paving the entire parking lot
- Special grotto dedicated to our Blessed Virgin Mary
- Upgrading the Church Basement to comply with SSF city codes

Your Parish Donations at Work —a Clarification

In light of questions raised stemming from the bulletin notice of October 14 regarding the article entitled “Your Parish Donations at Work”, I would like to offer some clarification: There is no doubt that the strength of the parish lies in you—as a community of faith journeying together along the footsteps of Christ. As a community, we are fortunate to have many vital parts—all parts working together in this one body. Many of the items noted in the last bulletin notice are a direct result of the efforts and generosity of those parishioners associated with our *Parish School* and, as we have seen year-after-year in our Parish Festival, we are the direct beneficiaries of the hard work of our parish school families. The Parish School, through its own operating budget or through the work of the School Guild, has managed to accomplish a variety of important measures which allow for the upkeep of the facilities: the painting of the school building and Falcon Hall, new blinds in Falcon Hall (the direct result of a private donation from a parish school family), the new fire alarm system going into the school, and the windows for the classroom doors. The architectural studies for the proposed conversion of the convent will be funded through monies set aside for capital improvements by the administration of the school which is built in part by matching grants from many parish school families past and present. The polishing of the Parish Center is provided annually by the efforts of the Men's Club. Lastly, the funds for the new fence, which we hope to see soon after the New Year, were raised by a special event last Spring. It was coordinated by the School Guild and attended by many parishioners—both seasoned and young!

It is our hope that the bulletin notice helped highlight the different hands in our Parish working together as one for the betterment of our faith community. We are most grateful to the parishioners who have given support throughout the years, whether they are associated with the parish school or any other parish program. We are truly a community of faith blessed with so many generous and dedicated families.

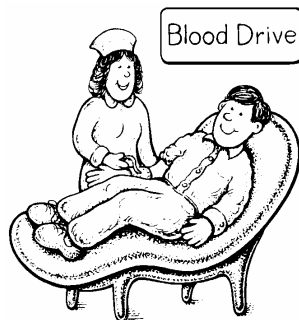
