THIS FATHER'S DAY

An archeologist once found an unusual clay tablet on the site of ancient Babylon in Iraq, which carried a message of greeting and hope from a son named Elmisu to his father some 4200 years ago. While most tablets from the remnants of royal archives address matters of diplomacy and business, this example reminds us of the uncounted fathers honored by families everywhere through time, just as we set aside days to especially celebrate our parents.

We may wonder about the history of Father's Day, which in the tradition of the Church is celebrated on the Feast of St. Joseph on March 19th. In the U.S., the first Father's Day occurred on July 5, 1908, in West Virginia. Shortly before, a mine disaster had taken the lives of 361 men, leaving many widows and orphans, which prompted a day of remembrance. Two years later in Spokane, Washington, Mrs. Sonora Dodd organized a celebration to honor her father Willam Smart, a veteran of the Grand Army of the Republic who had passed away. Family, friends, neighbors and GAR members joined Sonora on June 19, 1910, to mark the occasion which Sonora made special in a big way. She told everyone how extraordinary William was, a matchless father with a heart as great as the outdoors, a man of courage and generosity much loved by family and friends.

The newspapers mentioned Sonora and soon the idea of Father's Day drew wide support in the press, with support from notables such as William Jennings Bryan, later the 41st Secretary of State. Afterwards, in 1924, President Calvin Coolidge proclaimed the third Sunday in June as Father's Day. President Richard Nixon established its permanent observance in 1972. Today also, the red rose honors the occasion, while the white rose memorializes those who are deceased.

The Catholic Catechism says much on parenting, while fatherhood is God's gift allowing participation according to the Divine image. This role is special, to prepare children according to God's plan of life and salvation, leading them to their place as Christians in the world. Fatherhood reflects the family of Nazareth, fostering the model of love and virtue to be emulated by the young who will participate as believers in the miracle of the risen Christ. Today as always, may we remember to honor our fathers in prayer and love, mindful of all they have given to us and to our nation.

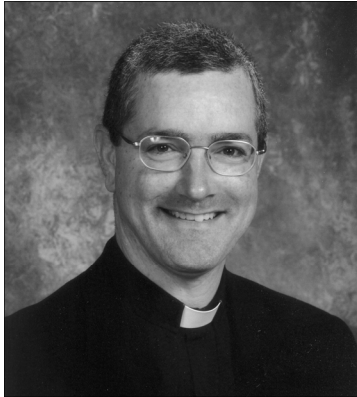
