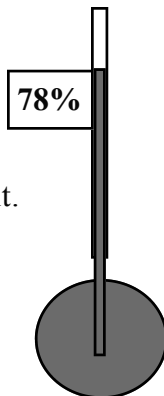
ARCHBISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL COLLECTION UPDATE
