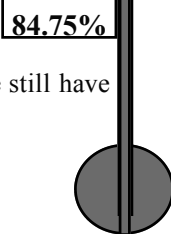

New Fence

Our gardening service has removed the landscape shrubs under the trees in front of the Church. New colorful trees and plants will be planted over the next several months.

Painting

Our Church exterior will be painted in the next few weeks. Scaffolding will be going up, first in the front of the Church, then on the side and back of the Church building. It Should take about three weeks to complete.
