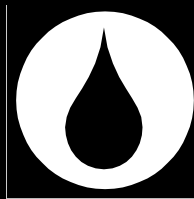

The year 2010 Daily Mass Reservation Book is now being used in the Rectory Office. The following is the Mass Book Policy.

- ◆ **Mass reservations will be taken on a “first-come, first-served” basis.**
- ◆ **Mass dates from previous years will *not* be carried forward automatically.**
- ◆ **People must come in-person to the Rectory to reserve Mass dates. Masses cannot be reserved by phone.**
- ◆ **The stipend for announced Masses is \$10 per Mass.**
- ◆ **Each family is not to exceed 12 Masses (one per month/one Saturday 5:00 pm Mass) per year.**
