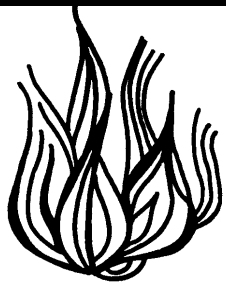

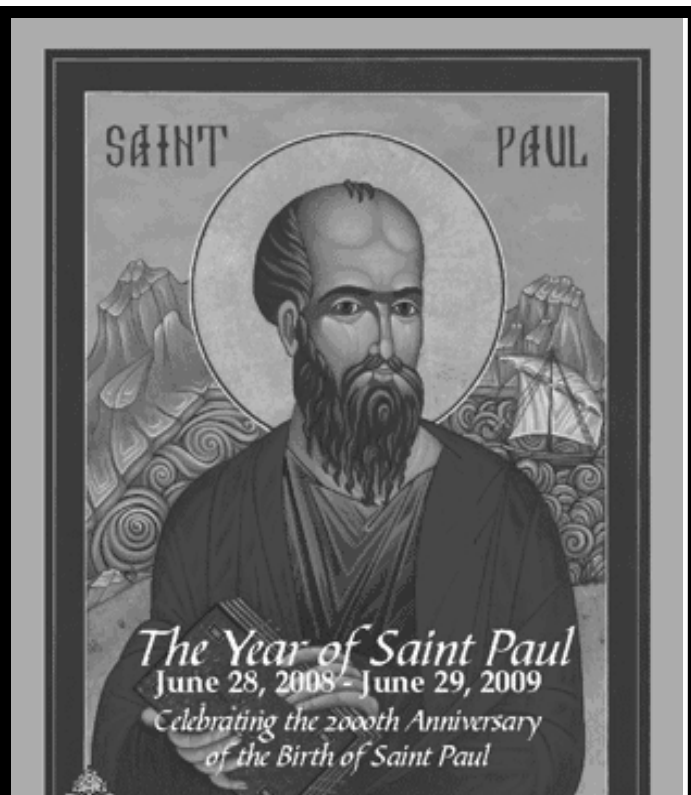

JUBILEE YEAR PLENARY INDULGENCE

The jubilee year gives the Church the opportunity to enjoy its spiritual bounty. We celebrate our communal life, which was so carefully shepherded by St. Paul wherever he preached. The jubilee affords us many opportunities for thanksgiving, prayer and reflection, especially as we devote ourselves to the Word of God and given in St. Paul's writings. Additionally, our Holy Father, Benedict XVI, has granted additional Holy Year opportunities to obtain indulgences for the full or partial remission of temporal punishment due to sin.

By virtue of the Decree of the Apostolic Penitentiary given May 10, 2008 regarding the Jubilee Year special indulgences conceded to the faithful within the Archdiocese of San Francisco, the *Plenary Indulgence* will be granted to "each and every truly repentant individual member of the Christian Faithful" who devoutly takes part in a sacred liturgy or a pious devotion in honor of St. Paul.
