Fr. Linh Nguyen was born in Vietnam in 1970, in a family of loving parents and 7 siblings. When he was a little boy he lived in a rectory with priests. After the communist take over in 1975, living one's Catholic faith was difficult. He left Vietnam upon graduation from high school for Hong Kong in 1989 and was in a refugee camp there for 5 years. In 1994, Fr. Linh, was sponsored by Fr. Tony McGuire, Pastor of St. Matthews Church in San Mateo. He studied at the University of San Diego. After graduation he applied to St. Patrick's Seminary in August, 1999 and was ordained a priest on June 5, 2004. Fr. Linh has been at St. Pius Church in Redwood City for 5 years. His hobbies are singing and concerts. Fr. Linh looks forward to coming to St. Veronica's Parish in October.
