SPIRITUALITY & PRAYER

SHARING MARY'S GREAT FAITH

It was by faith that Mary became Mother of the Son of God; it was by faith that she became blessed. "Blessed is she who believed that there would be a fulfillment of what was spoken to her from the Lord" (Luke 1:45).

It is by faith that we in our turn enter blessedness and life. Jesus tells Thomas: "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe" (John 20:29), and John ends his Gospel with these words: "These [signs] are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in his name" (John 20:31).

The faith meant here is a faith like Mary's: a living faith with the Trinity for its object and the Scriptures for its source; an active, joyous faith that is turned to the future.

The faith that makes human beings blessed is not primarily a set of formulas (a creed, which is a "symbol of faith") that needs only to be believed and recited. Neither is this faith an abstract "virtue" that can be neatly defined. No, it is a personal, mysterious encounter with the living God, the God of Jesus Christ. It would be better to say: faith is Abraham; above all, faith is Mary, whom we seek to imitate.

Mary's faith is already fully Christian and "Trinitarian," even though she could give no theological formulation of the Trinity. For she is the handmaid of God who causes his Son to be born in her through that power of love and life that is the Holy Spirit. Mary does not have a knowledge of the mystery that takes the form of clear concepts, but she lives the mystery of the Trinity in a deeply personal and intense way.

Our faith is in direct continuity with Mary's, for we are the servants and friends (John 15:15) of "Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, who was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary."

We believe that in our day the power of the Holy Spirit continues to cause Christ to be born and to grow in the hearts of men"...that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith: (Eph 3:17).

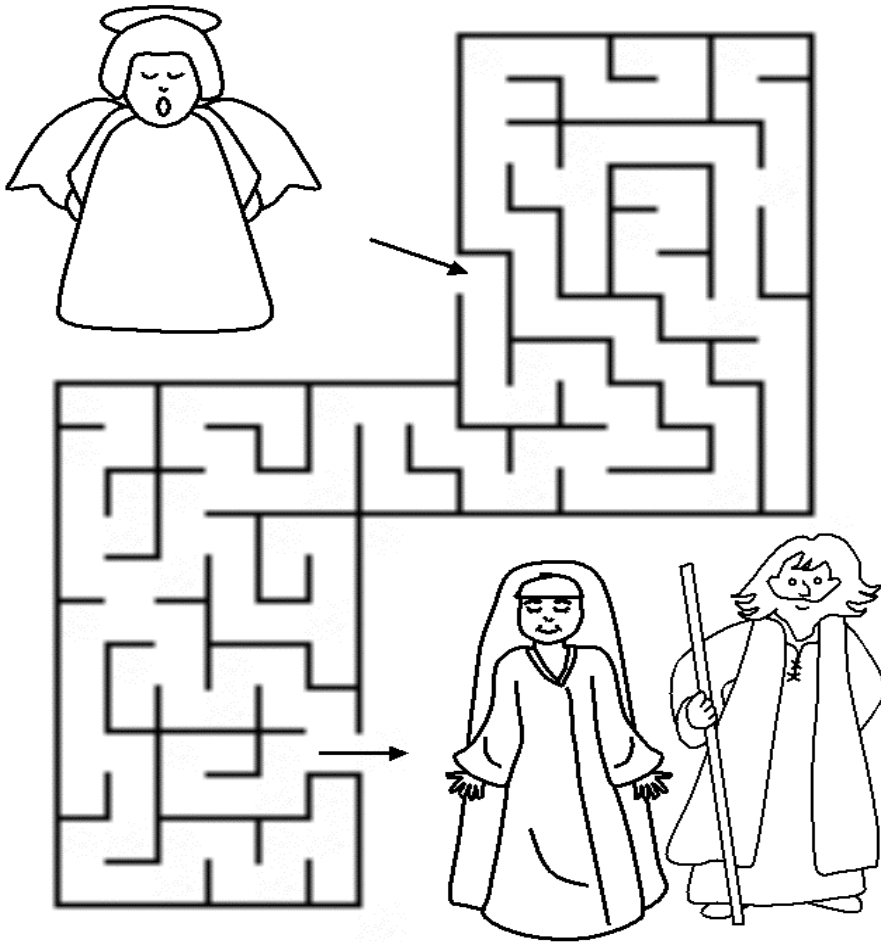

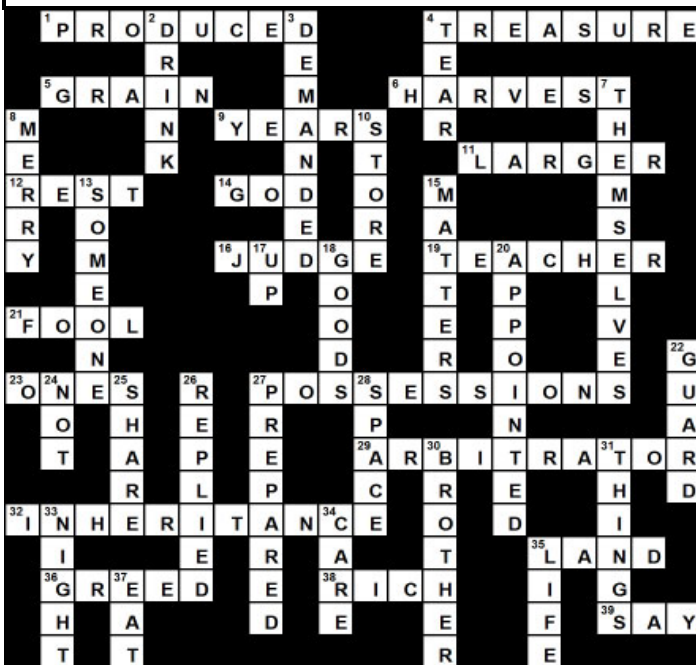
