Reflecting on God's Word

Writing, it seems, is mostly about waiting, though most of us tend to think of it as a pen-in-hand sort of thing, or a fingers-on-the-keyboard activity. Eventually it does come to that, but much of the time before can be spent waiting. Some would say it's waiting for the muse to show, or imagination to kick in, or for the idea to float free.

Anyone who has ever tried to do some writing—a description of what it's like to fall in love or a piece of poetry or an attempt to share the meandering path of a soul's journey—knows that such writing takes a great deal of waiting before it can happen, if indeed it ever happens at all. And sometimes when it does happen, it feels more like being found than it does like succeeding.

Many of the inner pieces of our lives seem to be like that. Discovering one's calling, falling in love, faith and the conversion that gives rise to it, recognizing the gifts sewn into the hems and cuffs of our lives—they all seem to find us rather than the other way around. Sometimes it's even in spite of our own efforts. Sometimes they feel like the very work and intention of the Divine One.

The scriptures are filled with stories of God doing the finding, even when we didn't know we'd been lost. That's the way it is with us and God—so often being found without even asking.

Dear Parishioners,

Capital Campaign Update: By the time you read this column, you'll be noticing that the slurry coating has been done on the new pavement of our property. My special thanks to the coordinator "trio" for the fabulous job done. During the parish festival, fundraising for Phase II will officially launch. Phase II will include all the pavement work except the upper parking lot. Terri, Sharon, and Tammi will also be speaking at all the Masses during that Festival weekend. Please give them all the support you can possibly give! Let's go and get the rest of the work done.

Legion of Mary: In our parish, we have a strong Legion of Mary ministry. Carmella Da San Martino is the overall coordinator of all four Legion of Mary groups. They have weekly meetings and combine their prayer with good deeds of service to others. Some members are also engaged actively with running the impressive hospitality event in the Parish Center after the 8:00 and 9:30 a.m. Masses on Sundays. Adoration: There is Adoration going on in our parish from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on weekdays. This is a great opportunity for those who can spend some time in prayer. Prayer can change our lives. Prayer is a loving relationship with God. Prayer will bring perspective in our lives. Prayer can heal, help, and transform our lives. Much comfort and strength can be drawn by being in contact with God in prayer.

There is too much going on in our lives. We need some clarity. So I recommend to you to consider Adoration as an opportunity for prayer. Word of God: Our God is a God of second chances. In one of the most appealing chapters in the Bible, Luke tells us in Chapter 15 about God giving us opportunities to turn our lives around and follow his ways. Jesus' three parables of the lost sheep, the lost coin, and the lost son are masterpieces of not only world literature, but also of spiritual renewal.

God looks at us always in loving ways, not condemning ways. Jesus is the face of God and in him we see how God loves us perfectly. Anthony de Mello says: "Look at Jesus looking at you lovingly and smiling." His look is one of love, not of judgment or condemnation. Paul in the second reading speaks of how the Lord didn't condemn him, but gave him a second chance. In the first reading as well, we see God relenting and forgiving---all because he is a God of love and mercy. There are two things we can conclude: One, to delight in God's most amazing and absolute love that is always forgiving and seeking our love-response. Two, to show similar love and compassion toward others, starting with our own family and friends, then extending it to even our enemies.

Movie Afternoon in the Pastoral Center: As you may know by now, new, state-of-the-art audio-visual equipment has been installed in the Veronica Room of the Pastoral Center. We have already had a movie show ("Mission") a few weeks ago. The next movie will be held at **1:00 p.m., on Thursday, September 19th**. The title of the movie is: "**Karol: The Man Who Became Pope.**" It is a powerfully told story of how the young man from Poland became John Paul II. The duration of the movie is three hours. With a bit of intermission after 90 minutes, you'll all be out of the parish "theater" by 4:30 p.m.

I can assure you that this movie will inspire you, especially in the light of the fact that John Paul II is going to be a canonized saint in the near future. Everyone is welcome! More movies to come in the future! The next one will be a sequel on John Paul II. Stay tuned!


